## Guthrie Bible Training Center Needs Your Help!



**GBTC Students**

During the past term at Guthrie Bible Training Centre, the intake of 35 people on the property was a challenge, as the school only accommodates 25 people. With limited support for the school, the school is run by faith! Through great hope and faith and prayer, we are moving forward as a team to run the school and trust God for provision. God is faithful, and each term in the past three years I have seen God's faithful provision. Preparation has started for the October Term. We are expecting even more students, and we are definitely preparing to dig pit latrines and wash bays in the field. Two toilets and two showers are not enough. This past term we also faced water shortage and thank God for Bill and Ruby Sutton from North Carolina who called me on the field and asked how they could help. Their financial help will bring water storage in at school to cope with school term needs. Pray with us for resources to develop the school and prepare property and buildings for the intake of 60 students in the future. The need is to complete a wall around the school by the end of 2014. The challenge is for 145 brick panels to be built at a cost of \$300 each. Would your church raise \$300 for the wall? Thank you Good News Ministries in Jacksonville, NC, you have raised funds for one panel!



**Eager students**

This is an urgent request and need! In December we are expecting 60 students to arrive to be trained in the ANNUAL CHILDREN'S WORKERS TRAINING session from 15-20th of December.
