Supporting the ministry in Malawi right now helps us take the Gospel to many others for generations to come. I wonder if Paul's supporters could have ever imagined that in 2010, IPHC missionaries would walk in Ephesus, now an ancient city, and talk about the ministry work accomplish by him and the Christians he encouraged.

The devotional time in Turkey during the African missionaries retreat was an amazing, spiritual, and emotional buffet. I thank World Missions Ministries and all of my supporters for being part of the opportunity we had to refresh, regroup, refocus, and reconsider the importance of every ministry opportunity we have. We came to realize that this is all part of the Christian history-making process, testifying to the work and example of Jesus Christ. A missions retreat is definitely highly appreciated and this one in Turkey gave me the most intense awakening: the importance of building and making history happen for the Christian faith and generations to come. ## Passing Through Greece

Passing through Greece on the way back to Malawi, I had the chance to experience a week of what God is doing among the Greek children and youth. I was amazed to experience the vision of a missionary called to reach the youth, children, and islands in Greece.

I volunteered as a helper, cleaning tables, working services, and sweeping the floors and patios throughout the day. I joined in with devotions, worship, Greek language classes, crafts, and served as the lifeguard's assistant during swimming sessions. The organizers just sent me a return request for next year's camp. In 2011, Malawian children's workers could accompany me and take a session everyday with the kids and talk about missions and mobilizing them as young prayer warriors for world evangelization. Pray with us for God's will to work in responding to this opportunity.

## Back in Malawi...

We are hosting district meetings, training leaders in children's ministry, women's conferences, training pastors in foundations for farming, presenting ADVANCE, planning kids camp, and preparing for youth camp and the annual children's workers training and outreaches in December. This year, we will also include training the youth to make a kitchen garden that works within the conditions of Malawi. This will help bring better nutrition to families.

Bible School will be in session again in October and 30 plus students will graduate. We are now working on the second level, translating subjects and training teachers to teach these subjects. Pray with us for increase in support for Guthrie Bible Training Center and for helpers to teach the English subjects. Consider this opportunity yourself, and let me know.

In January 2011, we are planning a Children's National Day of Prayer, mobilizing kids in Malawi to pray for Malawi and for the nations. Be in prayer as this ministry development makes history for the next generation!
