## Working for Harvest Time in Malawi




Christ was given so that we could receive eternal life, entering God's Kingdom redeemed and in righteousness we will stand before God, serving Him by loving His people and leading them in obedience. Thank God with me for His obedient servant, birthed and born by the power of His Holy Spirit, to bestow on us Our Heavenly Father's amazing grace and blessings. Let's celebrate the fruit of the harvest as I share the breakthrough ministry work in Malawi through 2010. A special thank you for your prayers and ministry support!

We completed three terms at Guthrie Bible Training Centre, graduating 17 students who earned a certificate for one year of Biblical Studies, which involves 15 subjects. 14 students will continue their studies in 2011 and 16 new students will join. The focus in 2011 is to mobilize more youth to attend Bible school, engaging them in a mentor program, developing future ministry teachers and leaders. The past year was also an opportunity to raise a national teaching team for GBTC. Three national teachers committed to continue teaching at GBTC in 2011 while continuing their development program as other teachers chose to pursue their education

development full time. Pray with us for this teaching team to arise, be appointed, anointed, and ordained by God to help take the school to another level of presenting courses. Be in prayer with us for a missionary couple who can serve full time, to direct the school, and have a heart for Christian education. Also, pray for volunteer workers and teachers to serve in Malawi at the school, helping build it up. Let me know if you are available to teach in 2011 for a two or three week period in February, June, or October. I will train, prepare, and see you through the teaching sessions giving you a great experience teaching Malawian nationals at GBTC!

Women's Ministries in Malawi made a commitment to be more effective in ministry and to develop a mentor program for girls in Malawi. After their leadership training by Sharon Wooten, they realized the amounts of opportunity to serve the church. The Leadership Training program was recorded and distributed on DVD for every region, helping leaders train, equip, and raise informed leaders, recognizing they are part of the international body as women in ministry.

Please pray for Mrs. Nancy Longwe as she leads the Women's Ministry in Malawi in strategic ministry as she works closely with her regional leaders. If your WM group desires to come and present encouraging messages, conduct crusades, or minister to orphans and widows, please let me know and we can make arrangements!



Soon it will be harvest time in Malawi! We look forward to the fruits of the bumper crops produced by our farming pastors who were trained in "Farming God's Way." This method uses "God's blanket" to retain moisture, which is especially helpful in areas where no rain is falling. When using this method, the farmer can produce a triple harvest every year instead of just one. Pray for our farmer pastors who implement this method, that they will see the expected results!

During the Advance Pastoral Training Program in November, I taught on Church Growth. The pastors and students committed themselves to implement the purpose of the church and develop programs to reach the lost and produce mature leaders for the church. They have a desire to see their churches healthy, in motion, and in a growth pattern as they aim to reach and teach people about God's



Kingdom principles. Pray with us for God's anointing on all pastoral and ministry leaders in Malawi, that they would lead people in obedience to God's Word. Let's pray that 2011 brings a bumper crop of harvesting souls!
