

Once the visitors left, preparation started for the Strategic Youth Leadership Training, the Annual Children's Workers Training Sessions, and then Youth Camp. December was another month full of ministry opportunities and January was filled with preparations for the February Bible school term at GBTC, where I taught Eternal Christ and David's Heart in the February term. Twenty four students came to take their next five subjects and 12 students came for their last term and graduated. We
