I'm on the mission field once again, and ready for a new season of ministry work, thanks to your continued faith commitments for the next three years to my personal support. Unrest has settled, but do keep Malawi in your prayers for peaceful developments!

The school term at Guthrie Bible Training Center began in October with great expectations, achieving greater academic achievements, and equipping strategic harvest workers and ministry leaders. The goal is to develop the school and prepare for an increase of students the next three years. Thanks for being a strategic partner in achieving this goal, being one of the 300 supporters sending \$10 monthly to raise harvest workers and ministry leaders in Malawi. I am expecting tons of vegetable seed packets with scriptures, filled with a word of encouragement to the youth. This is part of your impact toward the strategic youth development training sessions happening over the next four years. These sessions will equip Malawi youth to prepare themselves to care for their extended families and to be a strategic leader in their community. These youth will lead the way; caring, providing, and ministering the Gospel, leading their homes and villages out of poverty.

A medical outreach team lead by Zac Weaver (from Falcon Children's Home) will arrive in Malawi soon, and will serve as a great opportunity to plant churches. People will gather eagerly (so eager they will wait for days to be helped) as we distribute basic first aid resources, and through this process we have an opportunity to share the Gospel and minister to people with God's Word. The National Church Planting Team is ready to serve the community through planting a local church. Rev. Joe and Elsie Arthur will be in Malawi too, teaching "The Essential Ingredients of True Ministry" at GBTC.
