Fruit Abounds in the Ministry in Malawi

We serve in Malawi together - expressing God's love, life, and value to others. Remember Philippians 4:17-18. I desire fruit that may abound to your account...the things sent from you, an odor of a sweet smell, a sacrifice acceptable, well-pleasing to God.



Look at these gifts! I cannot express in words what this did to my heart! The vegetables were given after we washed the feet of the women in the village. The offering (equalling \$10) was given from the churches to start the Bible school term. Then, an orphanage in Malawi gave \$600 to help Guthrie Bible Training Centre (GBTC) begin the February term. God, I give thanks for seed to build your Kingdom! Increase it to accomplish great things for you and bless and refresh the givers! Proverbs 11:25, "The generous prosper and are satisfied; those who refresh others will themselves be refreshed."

I was joined by a missionary friend and Jan Overton, a 65 year old Emmanuel College intern, in the Zomba area where we were so humbled by the people. As we washed the ladies' feet, one woman said, "I feel like the child of a King," two others cried and were so grateful for the help with a fungal infection that had consumed flesh between their toes. The pastor there shared his needs for his family and the ministry work. HIV/AIDS deaths seem to be wiping out this community. There are only three men leaders helping the pastor with 20 women and 60 youth and children. Please keep this church in your prayers.



When we packed up, one woman asked us to leave them means to conduct the foot washing ministry among the rest of the area's women. We agreed and plan to follow-up to hear testimonies. In the meantime, we are preparing a course on HIV/AIDS from a Christian perspective, and the sessions are being translated into Chichewa. Cindy Caldwell, a retired nurse, will provide the training materials and will be part of the teaching team. We believe

this course will impact church members, preserving their generation so they may faithfully do the work of the ministry.

In Bwumbwe, Malawi, about 45 minutes from the missions home in Blantyre, we have a thriving church pastored by a woman who graduated from GBTC. Unfortunately, a violent storm came through the city and knocked the church's back wall to the ground. With the wall being down, the church became vulnerable to thieves who came in the night and stole the church's well pump.



After the incident, Jan and I delivered a "Well of Heaven" sermon at the church. It was at that service that Jan felt God place it on her heart to help with the re-building of the wall and replacing of the well pump. Praise God for His provision through His obedient vessels. At the end of the service, several young girls even responded to the "Well of Heaven!" Thank God no thief can steal the flow of living waters from them! Pray with us that they may follow in the footsteps of their pastor and develop a desire to lead others to the living well.



Between outreaches, preaching Sundays, hosting interns and visitors, and beginning the Bible school term, translation work is top priority. Richard, an administrator at GBTC, and other teachers are translating and retyping textbooks into Chichewa. Thank God for this team! Please pray as their task is challenging! The "Bibles for Malawi" #11643P program also helps with these resources. Last year's gifts from churches in North Carolina helped pay for Bibles for this year's need. 84 Bibles were purchased for new students of God's Word!

24 Chichewa Children's Bibles will raise 24 more children as Bible readers. Later, as follow-up, these kids receive a booklet of "HOPE" which will help them read a review from Genesis to Revelation on their level, in their language. Also, they receive a workbook to gain principles and memory verses to build a truth foundation. This is a new experience for kids in Malawi. These kids are being developed to become the future children's workers, Sunday school teachers, and Bible school students! Keep a watchful eye over Malawi's children and declare

and pray for them to grow spiritually and rise up as strategic Christian leaders! Thank you for helping build a nation through sending resources and supporting the project Child Evangelism Africa #10004P.



I was excited to have a classroom full of prayer warriors with a passion to mobilize kids to pray. The Children's Prayer Network instructors came from Australia to train Malawi church representatives, encouraging the development of the Malawi Children's Prayer Network. The PHC Malawi Children's Network attended the training and more than 70 students came representing various denominations. It was a glorious week as the teachers and students yielded to the Holy Spirit's moving, experiencing His miracle working power.

April 14 was the Global Day of Prayer for the 4/14 Window. This was a focus on reaching and evangelizing children 4 to 14 years old around the world. Our kid's groups gathered and prayed just outside Blantyre. Please pray with us for further development in mobilizing these young prayer warriors. With your support we are showing value, grace, and love! Thank you for making it possible for me to be a vessel and have the honor to serve Malawi with you!
