Part of our team are students who attended the last term at Guthrie Bible Training Centre (GBTC). They were a group with a greater passion for God's Word and for the lost. God is surely raising them up for a time such as this, and for a specific harvest field season. This past term GBTC embraced 20 students from PH churches all over Malawi. This was the first full PH student class since we reopened the school in 2000. Usually we have 50 percent PH students and 50 percent private students. Thank

God with me for the PH pastors who are sending more students. The northern Malawi students need extra help attending GBTC because it is located in Southern Malawi. We had no attendance from the north the past years, but with this sponsorship, it was made possible. Their travel fees are high on top of the school fees - it takes 10-15 hours by bus - and is overwhelming for them. Will you work with me to help raise school support for 10 students, currently at \$50 each per term, being \$150 per year to complete their ONE -YEAR Certificate in Biblical Knowledge. Soon it will be time to celebrate the finishing of renovations at Bethany Mission House! Thanks to my son Carl and the team of workers who stuck together for two years and faced all the challenges to make it through to the final stages. Our goal is to function more effectively and host more visitors and teams to come and work in the ministry. Changes were made to change outside rooms into a guest area, develop a kitchen next to the outdoor cooking area, extend the patio, tighten up security, add lighting, and harvest water for a vegetable garden. It was also time to repaint the house after

12 years! Thank you to my daughter Gaby who helped with kitchen units, the dining room table, and drum chairs she no longer needed at her house. I am still standing in faith to replace the washing machine and dryer after 20 years. Currently, we are running it by hand-filling the water into the washing drum as the water inlet cannot be repaired any longer. Should you want to help with these items, in Malawi now one would pay \$4325.00 for both. Thank God for the \$140 already sent! This is a special project for Malawi Mission House Renovations Acc #11638P.

Great celebrations took place on the 20th of April when 40 street kids were moved into their new home with their guardian parents Godknows and Helen. There was tremendous excitement about the new home, and as you arrive, you will have a full tour while your hand is held tightly

by the youngest child in the house. The Minister of Gender representing the Government arrived as the guest speaker and praised this couple for their faithfulness to do this work. This street kids program developed in our missions home while training Godknows in curtain making. From 2006, after he attended the children's workers training sessions and attended Guthrie Bible Training Centre, Godknows expressed his desire to work with street kids. I was able to stay in contact with him as a coach and mentor, and helped him to raise a team of workers to come alongside him. Now, the kids are taught in KIDS Club weekly and the youth attend Agricultural Training, Children's Workers Training, and Youth Camp. The youth now grow vegetables to use for meals and also for raising funds.

Thank God for children and the ones we have been trusted with. May God daily work in their hearts His Will and Direction. My son Carl now has a desire to join World Missions Ministries as an affiliated worker. Pray for this process as he applies, and as we attend the IPHC's General Conference in Dallas and the School of Missions. We hope to meet you there and we hope to set a date to visit your church next year between July - September 2014. Thank you for your prayers and support, and let us celebrate HIS TIME and HIS SEASON for HIS WORK!
